In July, St. John's will also send a middle school mission team (grades 6-8) to Birmingham, AL, to partner with YouthWorks, working alongside nonprofits to support lower-income areas of the city. 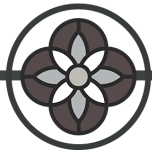
