Market Grants at Work in Tallahassee

The 2021 St. John's Market was a huge success, thanks to our extensive team of volunteers! We raised \$28K after expenses, which funded \$14K in grants to local organizations. Projects include weekly music therapy for Alzheimer's patients, new air purifiers Grace Mission needed before re-opening to the community, and more! 1st Annual Remembrance at Local Memorial

In early 2020, the Tallahassee Community Remembrance Project (TCRP), a coalition of 46 local organizations and faith communities, including St. John's, led a soil collection ceremony at the spot in Cascades Park that would eventually house a narrative marker. The purpose of the marker is to help citizens acknowledge past and present racial violence and injustice, including the four documented victims of lynching in Leon County. The marker, dedicated this past summer, will be the backdrop of TCRP's first annual remembrance on Saturday, 2/12, at 2 PM. After the ceremony, St. John's will host the community for presentations by faculty members from FSU's History & Women's Studies departments. Both events open to the public.

New Series: "Walking the Mourner's Path"

When someone in our life dies, the resonance affects our entire being. This Lent, St. John's will once again offer "Walking the Mourner's Path," an 8-week grief support program that reminds us that God is present in our pain and we are not alone in our grief. The upcoming series of workshops will be led by Mother Abi, Melanie Salsgiver, and Deacon Joe. Contact Mtr. Abi if you'd like to participate. Our registration deadline is February 20.
