At two of today's services, FSU graduate student Dawson Coleman and St. John's Organist Elizabeth LaJeunesse will play movements from Steven Banks' recent work for tenor saxophone and piano, "Come As You Are." Each movement is based on a traditional Spiritual or a song from the Black Gospel tradition. "Lift My Eyes" (based on "My Lord, what a morning"), is fast, with elements of jazz and romanticism, while "Strength of My Life" (based on "His Eye is on the Sparrow"), is slow, reflective, and poignant. At 5:30 PM we'll also hear the energetic and dance-like "Times of the Storm," which is based on "Wade in the Water."
