Service of Choral Evensong – May 15

Join us next Sunday at 5:30 PM, for the beautiful Service of Evensong, one of the oldest in the Anglican tradition, dating back to the original Book of Common Prayer of 1549. Evensong is a combination of the monastic offices of Vespers (sung at sunset) and Compline (sung before bedtime), and is drawn almost entirely from the Bible. Musical components include psalms, hymns, anthems, and the canticles Magnificat and Nunc dimittis.
