CAMPUS NEWS

New Flooring for Calhoun Street Hallway

This week, while the Café was closed for summer break, we were able to complete some outstanding projects funded by the "For All the Saints" Capital Campaign, and a special project financed by a longtime St. John's ministry.

NEW HALLWAY FLOORING: New floors were installed in the Calhoun Street hallway, and in the foyer outside Alfriend Hall/Lively Café, thanks to funding from the Capital Campaign. The new flooring is Luxury Vinyl Tile (LVT), the same product used in the Killeen Hall entryway and the Rutledge Room (Multipurpose Room). In the hallway, the surface was leveled and the new floor was installed directly over the existing, aging tile. The new, highly durable, commercial-grade flooring is ideal for this heavy traffic area, which connects some of our most-used campus spaces.

HVAC EVALUATION: Additional Capital Campaign funds are being used this summer to conduct a system-wide HVAC evaluation of the entire St. John's campus.

RUTLEDGE ROOM VANITY: A mirror and pair of wall sconces was recently installed in the vestibule outside the Rutledge Room and the handicap-accessible restroom off the breezeway. St. Mary's Circle generously funded the improvements in this space, which will be used mostly by those getting married at St. John's.

Thank you to our Property Commission for overseeing the remaining Capital Campaign funds and for working with the Finance Committee on approvals for all of these projects!
