Beware of Email "Phishing" Scams!

Over the past few days, St. John's has received reports from a number of parishioners regarding of a new round of "phishing" scams, or fake emails attempting to secure personal or financial information. Unfortunately, churches are a particular target! Please know that Fr. Lonnie and our diocesan leadership will NEVER solicit money, favors, gift cards, etc. via email. Such requests are fraudulent and should be immediately ignored and deleted. St. John's clergy will ONLY ever email from their official church email address. 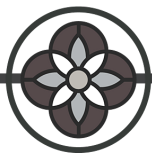
