Uncovering Church History

After today's 10 AM service, gather with us in Killeen Hall to learn about parish efforts to identify the souls buried in St. John's Historic Cemetery. This effort first began in the early 90s, for a member's Eagle Scout project.

Then, from 2016-2022, four dedicated parishioners worked to complete this research and tell the stories of the families buried in this sacred space. Most recently, our historians have sketched out St. John's timeline and what was happening simultaneously in Florida's history.

Today, we'll highlight these historical eras and share about the family graves within those time periods.
