Donations Needed for Cuba Mission

This spring, when our Cuba mission team heads to Zorrilla, Cuba to visit and partner with our brothers and sisters, they will also transport essential food, medicine, and supplies donated by St. John's. We will be sharing a different "donation assignment" weekly, based on the items most requested by our friends in Cuba. This coming week, please bring Children's Tylenol (Acetaminophen) liquid and Motrin (Ibuprofen) liquid, chewable Tylenol for children, and colic medicine (drops) for babies. Also for adults: Ibuprofen, Tylenol (Acetaminophen), regular aspirin, 81 mg aspirin, pain relievers for migraines, and Aleve (Naproxen). These donations can be dropped off by Sunday, 1/29.

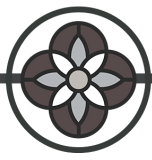
