This afternoon, the St. John's Historical Society invites you to visit our parish's historic cemetery. Established in 1840, it is one of the earliest Christian burial sites in Florida. Chat with docents to hear vibrant stories of religious commitment, trailblazing souls, wars, and shipwrecks, and learn how we maintain this historic space so it will be around for generations to come.
