### A FULL SUMMER Serves Local Children

It was fabulous to see so many St. John's members out last weekend at "A FULL SUMMER's 2023 Snack Pack!" This idea-born of St. John's "Visioning the Vineyard" strategic planning process with a goal of feeding children during the summer months-has grown by leaps and bounds over the past 10 years. This year, A FULL SUMMER raised more than \$36,000 and gathered more than 250 volunteers at Godby High School to pack 7,000 bags of nutritious snacks for food-insecure children. Second Harvest of the Big Bend will distribute the snacks to Leon County Schools' food pantries, as well as community centers, and any location where foodinsecure children gather.
