"Living Waters" Improvements in Cuba

This November is the 10th anniversary of the installation of the Living Waters for the World water treatment system at St. John's companion church, San Pedro Apóstol in Zorrilla, Cuba. The mission team that we are sending next month will be the first team to benefit from the reconfiguration of Zorrilla's water treatment system. During a visit to Cuba in early 2023, St. John's parishioners committed funds to upgrade the system, and our partners in Cuba set about making improvements (creating a more durable structure, and building and plumbing a new bottle-filling station near the church's outdoor meeting space).
