St. John's Baptismal Font

The baptismal font at St. John's has a long and storied history. Given in 1856 by the children of the parish, it is one of the few items that survived the great fire of 1879. Having been in continuous use for 168 years, it has seen St. John's faithful through generations of change, not immune to its own knocks and bruises along the way. In recent decades, the three pieces that compose it—pedestal, pillar, and bowl—have been extremely unstable.

Earlier this week during the bustle of post-Easter cleanup, the font was inadvertently knocked over, breaking the bowl into four large pieces. Fortunately, we are blessed with the knowledge and skill of our friends at Florida State University's Master Craftsman Studio, whose representatives came immediately to assess the damage. They were able to stabilize the pedestal and pillar immediately, and the bowl is currently in their care as they assess the best approach to repair and reattachment.

Eastertide is the season of resurrection and grace, a time when we remember that despite our brokenness and imperfections, God has restored us and given us a glorious future. Likewise, our baptismal font will be restored to serve for generations yet to come. Whatever cracks may show will be a new chapter in its long story, a constant reminder of the Easter promise that God is forever making all things new.
