

## Attendance Policy

The status of "In Good Standing" is required for all students to fully participate in all CS activities. This is defined as:

- 1. Regularly attending weekday rehearsals (1x for Joyful Noisemaker, 2x for Junior Choristers, 1x for Senior Choristers) ~ minimum of 75% attendance.
- 2. Attending and singing the minimum number of services per semester (0x for Joyful Noisemaker, 16x for J&S Choristers, 6x for J&S Choristers w/ other faith commitments\*).

\*For our families with other faith commitments (which is almost half of our enrollment!), please note that there are many opportunities to sing at St. John's. In the Fall 2025 semester alone, there are <u>33 services</u> that the choristers can sing, <u>17 of which are not on Sunday mornings.</u> This is an important part of the program and allows **all** students to participate in the important mission of leading worship through song, which is a primary goal of the SJCS.

SJCS students who <u>are not "In Good Standing"</u> will not be eligible to receive piano lessons and will not receive chorister pay for that semester. "Good standing" status will reset at the beginning of a new semester, with the understanding that efforts will continue to be made to remain in compliance.
