

## Instrumental Lesson Policy

Instrumental lessons are offered on a first come, first served basis, and limited spots are available. Choristers are expected to attend lessons regularly and remain 'in good standing' as a Choir School student (attending all required rehearsals/services and abiding by the Choir School Code of Conduct). As these lessons are in demand, a strict attendance policy is now in place to allow this opportunity to be utilized by all students who wish to take lessons. After 3 unexcused absences in a semester, the choir school student and family will be notified that their lesson spot will be made vacant for another student.

## Definitions

- If a chorister must miss a lesson, please make sure to inform Ms. Hall and Mrs. Barrow at least 48 hours in advance. This counts as an **excused absence**.
- If a chorister misses a lesson without advance notice, this is an unexcused absence.
- If a chorister arrives more than 5 minutes late to a lesson, this is considered **tardy attendance.**
- Please note the following:
  - o 3 tardy attendances in a semester will count as one unexcused absence.
  - 2 excused absences in a semester will count as one unexcused absence.

Please be advised that it is the responsibility of the student to remember and **bring their piano book with them to each lesson**.
